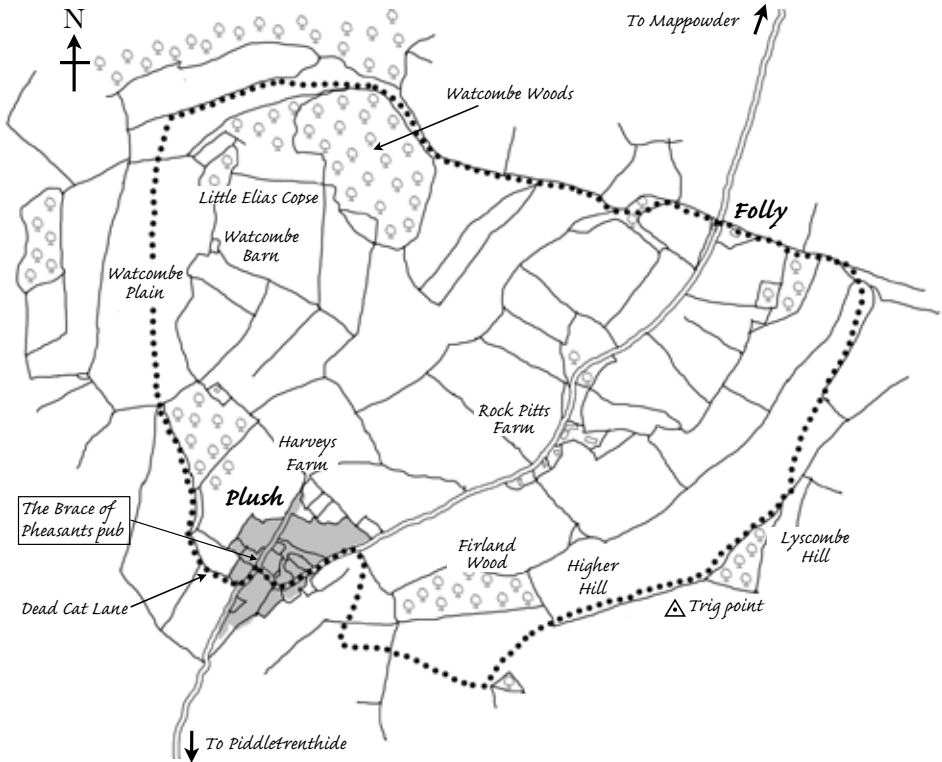

Route: Around Plush

One of the best routes in the Piddle valley with extensive views in all directions.

Perhaps the best is from Lyscombe Hill looking south east across the magnificent Lyscombe Bottom, on a good day almost as far as the coast.

There are two hard climbs out of the valley but well worth the effort!

If we get snow it is particularly stunning.

use of an Ordnance Survey map is recommended.

..... Route

The route is 4.3 miles of road, tracks and rough terrain mostly along public rights of way.

Stout footwear is recommended.

The route is best started from the centre of Plush or from Folly.

Not all hedgelines or tracks are shown.

If you are reasonably fit it should take about 2 hours.
